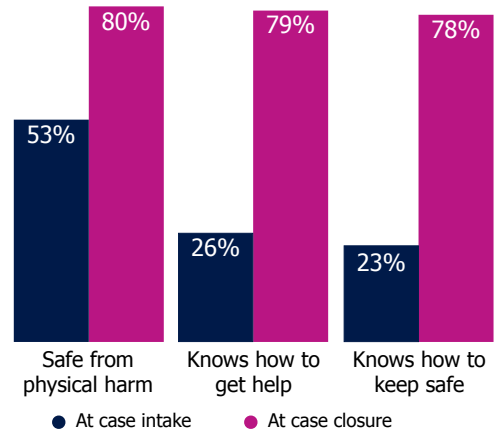

Support given by specialist domestic abuse practitioners

- **65%** reported a cessation of abuse at case closure
- On average each client supported with **4** interventions
- Safety plans made with **95%** of clients
- Case workers report reduction in risk in **74%** of cases (**31%** significantly)
- **77%** of clients felt somewhat or much safer
- **76%** of clients reported that their quality of life had improved

Discussed **74,052** cases

Involving **93,759** children

Of which **1,292** were aged 16-17

And **677** involved a young person causing harm

Support given by Young People's Violence Advisors



89% received wellbeing advice and support

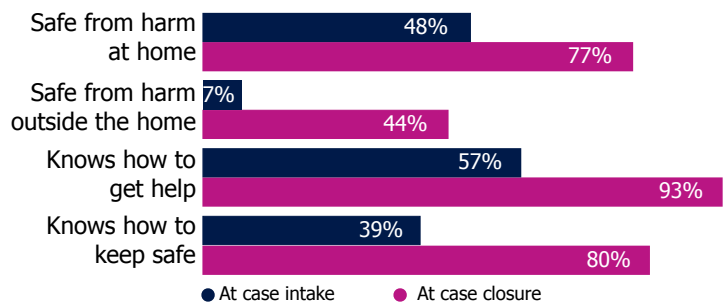
59% received health advice and support
